MELTA signs MoU with ELT association in Nepal

The Malaysian English Language Teaching Association has signed a memorandum of understanding with the Nepal English Language Teachers' Association based in Kathmandu.

With the official signing of the MoU, MELTA now has 14 international partnerships with ELT associations. These partnerships are vital in ensuring that MELTA members are part of a global community of ELT practitioners. The MoU will see both associations supporting the continuing professional development of their members and the wider English language teaching community.

The presidents of both associations expressed hope that the MoU will lead to closer ties between Nepal and Malaysia. Both associations are already engaged in an initiative with the Bangladesh English Language Teachers Association to encourage cross-border research ties across the three countries.

MELTA was founded in 1992 and provides a platform to support the professional development of teachers of English in Nepal. The association is particularly committed to enhancing ELT in Nepal by improving the teaching and learning of the English language, and ensuring that teachers keep abreast of new developments in ELT.

MELTA is a not-for-profit organisation which is committed to the promotion of English language education in Malaysia. The association was founded in 1958 and is the oldest English language teaching association in Malaysia.
