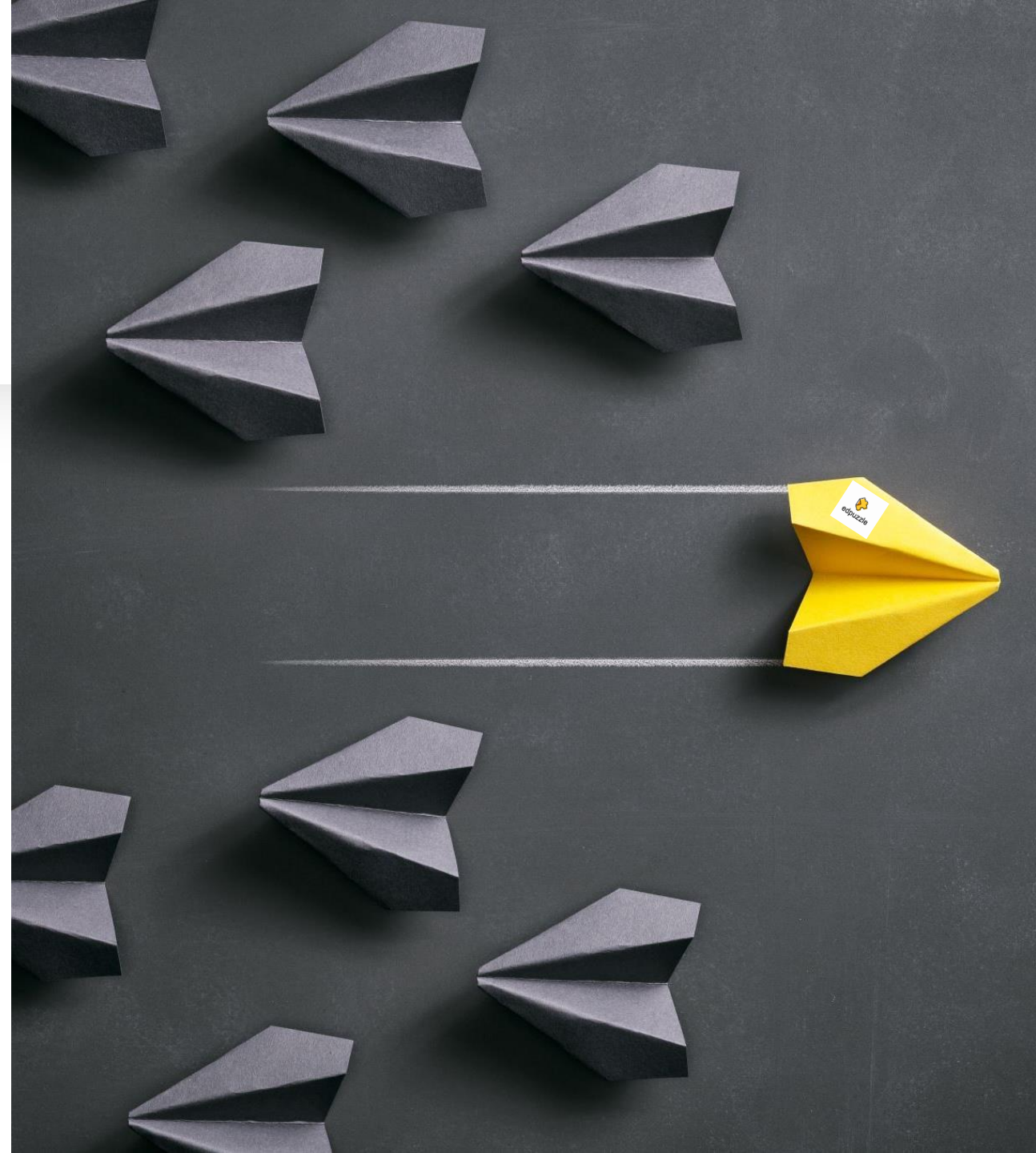

Edpuzzle in Malaysia

- Edpuzzle has been integrated with the 1Delima platform (<https://d2.delima.edu.my/>), and will be used as a tool in the classroom in tandem with Google Classroom, as encouraged by the Malaysian Ministry of Education.



MELTA's Deliverables

- To offer free materials adaptation workshops for English Language Teaching ("ELT") practitioners during the term of the Agreement.
- In addition to offering hands-on activities during these Workshops, each participant will also work towards becoming a certified Edpuzzle Coach (<https://learn.edpuzzle.com/coach>) which will allow them to train other teachers on how to use the Edpuzzle Service.





Workshop Objectives

- (a) to train Participants on how to use videos to create supplementary listening, speaking, reading and writing activities for use during lessons or as independent learning material for English language learners;
- (b) to have Participants certified as Edpuzzle Coaches as part of their continuing professional development journey; and
- (c) to equip Participants so that they may be able to train their peers on using videos for materials adaptation.

MELTA will:

- Create video materials in Edpuzzle that are aligned with CEFR standards.
- Provide training sessions to participants during each Workshop.
- Ensure that **a minimum of one hundred (100) teachers and pre-Service teachers undergo an Edpuzzle certificate training course at Levels 1 and 2, and an additional fifty (50) teachers and pre-Service teachers complete an Edpuzzle course as certified coaches.**
- Collaborate with Edpuzzle in the promotion of the Workshops.





Outcomes



Outcome 1: Development of Workshop Content

- A team of experts made up of academics, teacher trainers and an officer from the Curriculum Development Centre, Ministry of Education Malaysia conceived the idea for a Materials Adaptation Workshop specifically for English Language teachers in Malaysia.
- The workshop made references to the existing CEFR-aligned curriculum standards, and all activities were related to the teaching of English in primary and secondary schools.
- The 6-hour workshop also embedded activities to ensure that participants were familiarised with the Edpuzzle platform, completing “Edpuzzle Level 1,” “Edpuzzle Level 2,” and “Edpuzzle Coach”.

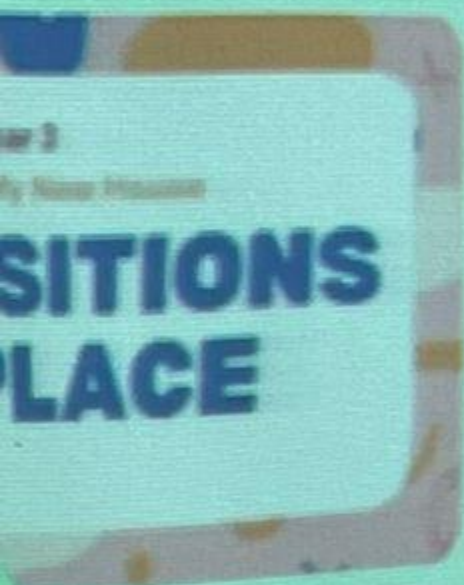


Outcome 2: Meeting targets for Edpuzzle Coach certification

- MELTA collaborated with the Ministry of Education Malaysia through its Training Bureau and MELTA Chapters located throughout Malaysia to train in-service and final-year pre-service teachers
- Workshops were conducted in Kuala Lumpur, Kuantan, Penang, Kedah and Sarawak.
- Final year pre-service teachers were included with the support of the Teacher Training Division of the Ministry of Education Malaysia. These teachers will soon be posted to schools throughout Malaysia, thereby increasing the probability that information will be shared with more teachers on ways to use the Edpuzzle platform for ELT, as well as other subjects.

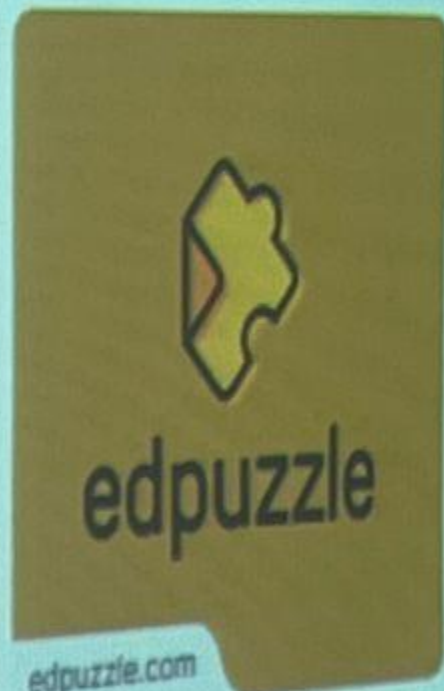

Participant Feedback

- The EdPuzzle workshop was an engaging and helpful experience for all participants. While it offered valuable insights into using EdPuzzle effectively, there was a consensus that the workshop could benefit from more hands-on activities and an extension to two days to allow for deeper exploration of the platform's features.
- One of the most noteworthy aspects of the EdPuzzle workshop was its level of engagement. The workshop facilitator employed various strategies to keep participants actively involved throughout the day. These strategies included interactive presentations, group discussions, and live demonstrations of EdPuzzle's functionalities. These approaches effectively held participants' attention and facilitated a dynamic learning environment.



Participant Feedback

- The workshop content was highly informative and provided participants with a strong foundation in using EdPuzzle as an educational tool. Topics covered included creating and editing video lessons and integrating quizzes. The presenter shared valuable tips and best practices for creating engaging and effective video lessons, which were well-received by the participants.
- One area where the workshop could be improved is by incorporating more hands-on activities. While the presentations and demonstrations were informative, participants expressed a desire for more time for practical exercises that would allow them to apply their learning in real-time.

Participant Feedback

- A common sentiment among participants was that the workshop would benefit from an extension to two days. Given the depth and breadth of EdPuzzle's features, a second day would provide ample time for participants to delve into advanced functionalities and explore additional ways to leverage the platform in their teaching. This extension would also allow for more in-depth hands-on activities and opportunities for collaborative projects.
- In conclusion, the EdPuzzle workshop was a valuable experience for the participants, offering engaging and helpful insights into the platform's capabilities. However, there is room for improvement in terms of incorporating more hands-on activities and extending the workshop to two days would allow for a more comprehensive exploration of EdPuzzle. These enhancements would further enhance the workshop's value and help participants become proficient EdPuzzle users.
