MELTA AND AIESEC in MALAYSIA INK MOU

The Malaysian English Language Teaching Association (MELTA) and AIESEC in Malaysia have inked a memorandum of understanding to jointly organise workshops and training sessions which support the aspirations of SDG4 for quality education and lifelong learning.

AIESEC is a global platform for young people to explore and develop their leadership potential. The organisation is run by youths and recent graduates of institutions of higher education.

AIESEC is a non-governmental, not-for-profit organisation which operates in consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC). AIESEC International is registered as a foundation in Rotterdam, The Netherlands.

MELTA's Training Bureau will oversee collaborative engagements involving both organisations. Soon after the official signing of the MOU, the MELTA Training Bureau and AIESEC in Malaysia ran a training programme on 27 June 2020 for university undergraduates on workshop management skills. The event was facilitated by Associate Professor Datin Dr Cynthia Yolanda Doss, the Director of the Post Graduate Certificate of Higher Education programme, University of Nottingham Malaysia and Senior Fellow, Higher Education Academy, UK.

MELTA is a not-for-profit organisation which is committed to the promotion of English language education in Malaysia. The association was founded in 1958 and is the oldest English language teaching association in Malaysia.
